Distribution from an IRA

If you are 70½ years old or older, you can take advantage of a simple way to support tomorrow's cures and receive tax benefits in return. You can give up to \$100,000 from your IRA directly to The Jackson Laboratory without having to pay income taxes on the money.

Why Consider This Gift?

- Your gift will be put to use today, allowing you to see the difference your donation is making.
- You pay no income taxes on the gift. The transfer generates neither taxable income nor a tax deduction, so you benefit even if you do not itemize your deductions.
- If you have not yet taken your required minimum distribution for the year, your IRA charitable rollover gift can satisfy all or part of that requirement.

How to Make this Gift?

Simply instruct your IRA Fund manager to forward your gift directly from the account payable to:

Note: if you are writing a check from your IRA to make a charitable gift, please send your gift several weeks before December 31. With IRA charitable qualified distributions, the date of gift is <u>not</u> established when you mail your check. Rather, the date of gift is established when the IRA administrator transfers funds after JAX deposits the check. This is very important if you are relying on your gift to meet your required minimum distribution for the year.
