Detailed Description

Mice hemizygous for the BLG-Cre transgene are viable and fertile, with the beta-lactoglobulin (BLG) promoter directing Cre recombinase expression to mammary gland during lactation. When these BLG-Cre transgenic mice are bred with mice containing *LoxP*-flanked sequences, Cre-mediated recombination will result in deletion of the floxed sequences in *cre*-expressing tissues in the offspring.

Of note, the donating investigator of the triple mutant *BLG-Cre; Brca1^{F22-24/F22-24}; p53^{+/-}* mice (Stock No. [012620](#)) reports that mice should be allowed to go through two rounds of pregnancy and then set aside to allow Cre activation and the loss of floxed gene function.

Breeding Considerations

When maintaining a live colony, mice hemizygous for the *BLG-cre* transgene may be bred with wildtype (noncarrier) mice from the colony.

Of note for Cre recombinase applications, the donating investigator of the triple mutant *BLG-Cre; Brca1^{F22-24/F22-24}; p53^{+/-}* mice (Stock No. [012620](#)) reports that mice should be allowed to go through two rounds of pregnancy and then set aside to allow Cre activation and the loss of floxed gene function.
