## Details

### Detailed Description

These *Agt<sup>fl</sup>* mutant mice possess *loxP* sites flanking exon 2 of the angiotensinogen (*Agt*) gene. AGT is a circulating  $\alpha$ -2-globulin produced mainly by the liver. It is the only known precursor to the peptide angiotensin II (ANG II), which is a hormone linked to hypertension. Mice that are homozygous for this allele are viable, fertile, normal in size and do not display any gross physical or behavioral abnormalities. When bred to mice that express tissue-specific Cre recombinase, resulting offspring will have exon 2 deleted in the *cre*-expressing tissues.

For example when bred to B6.Cg-Tg(Fabp4-cre)1Rev/J mice (Stock No. [005069](#)), AGT depletion in adipocytes results in decreased systolic blood pressure and reduced circulating AGT concentrations.
